



UNIFORM POLICY

City School requires a standard of dress with a school uniform. While a uniform can promote a range of goals, at City School our aim is to practice the following:

At City School, we hope to encourage students to think of their attire as an aspect of their work, much as adults do for professional attire, and to prioritize habit development when preparing to come to school each day.

A standard of dress can also offer opportunity for students to practice honoring established community expectations and can cultivate school spirit.

Finally, given our mission, we hope to protect the learning environment from distractions such as social competition and focus on the outward appearance.

Overall, students are expected to be in uniform whenever they are at school or on field trips. Students should arrive at school and leave from school in the appropriate uniform for that day. Parents are asked to follow the “when in doubt, don’t” rule of thumb when purchasing uniform pieces. To promote attention in the classroom, teachers and administration may determine it is most helpful to have a student store distracting or non-compliant attire or accessories in their backpack.

If purchasing uniforms is difficult for financial reasons, please let a front office staff member or school administration know. Please note that there is a uniform donation closet with some items that are gently used and readily available, and there's also a uniform ministry at our school that is donation based. Please let us know if you desire assistance from this ministry with acquiring uniform compliant items. As our Parent Partnership Agreement states, parents commit to establish and maintain a growth-oriented, collaborative relationship with City School staff built on communication characterized by trust, respect, and empathy. In alignment with this agreement, parents are asked to support the school administration as the final authority in matters of the uniform policy, as well as appropriate dress and appearance at school and school functions. We review our uniform policy yearly and welcome feedback. Uniform policy feedback can be sent to school administration.

NEW in 2025-26:







- A colored shirt has been requested for a variety of reasons, so we are adding light blue shirts as an option thanks to students advocating for a change.
- Field Trip t-shirt. When students are headed out on an outdoor field trip, it helps to spot students when everyone is in the same shirt, and it helps those outside of our community know who is with which group. This t-shirt will be available at Back-to-School Night.
- Fifth-eighth graders may wear jeans on outdoor field trips and service projects as determined by the teacher.
- Fridays CS t-shirt of choice. As long as a class is not going on a field trip, they may wear any CS t-shirt. As a reminder to students, t-shirts that have been signed with Sharpies are not allowed.
- NOT New, but a good place for a reminder: classes attending plays/performances or going to museums for field trips will wear their chapel uniform.
- NOT totally new, but to acknowledge the changes the older students (5th-8th graders) have had to their uniform in the last year, they will have 6 dress down days.



HAIR

- Full head of bright-colored or unnatural hair color is not allowed; bright or unnatural hair color highlights and dyed tips are allowed.
- Boy's hair length should be above the shoulder.
